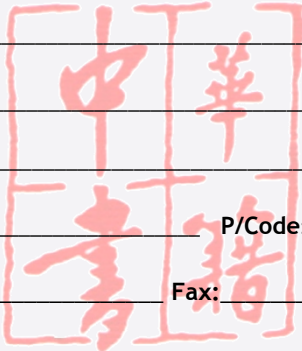

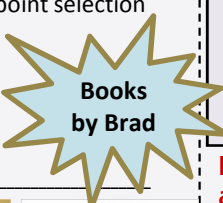

He is a native of Oregon, graduating from the Oregon College of Oriental Medicine and later from Emperors College with his DAOM.
