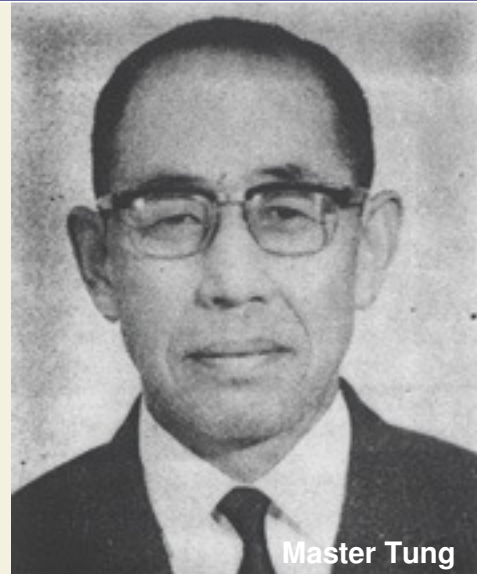

About the Seminar:

- Tung's Acupuncture is believed to predate the Nei Jing (Inner Classic) and was kept alive through the centuries in Shandong Province. When Dr. Tung was forcibly moved to Taiwan in 1949, he broke the ancient Tung family tradition by openly publishing what had been regarded as closely guarded secrets.
- Tung's school of acupuncture differs from the average Chinese acupuncture. It does not make use of the meridian concept but utilizes Tung's 500 unique points. There is a special method of induction and acceleration taught by the late Master Tung, which can induce a very speedy recovery of one's energy in most conditions.
- This clinically effective system is based on the use of 23 points per treatment. Practitioners will be trained about the unique repertoire of points, locations, indications and needling instructions of this system. As well, comprehensive case studies will be covered.
- Tung's Acupuncture is considered to be very safe, with the majority of the points located on the extremities rather than in the core of the body. Few points are needed in any given treatment, which makes it a simple and effective system to employ. Recent studies have showed that the central nervous system can auto-regulate such a process, thus increasing the beneficial effects of needling.
- Dr. Palden Carson is an experienced Tung's Acupuncture practitioner and was one of the few disciples entrusted by the late Master Tung with the task of sharing his teachings outside China. Under the guidance of Carson, practitioners will enhance their practical skills by working closely and informally with their peers.

Master Tung in his youth gained a reputation for compassion by providing free acupuncture services. Later he started to take on apprentices and disciples in order to pass on his knowledge. His followers came to include Taiwan Chinese, Vietnamese and Canadian medical doctors. Dr Palden Carson, a Tibetan, was one of his first students.
