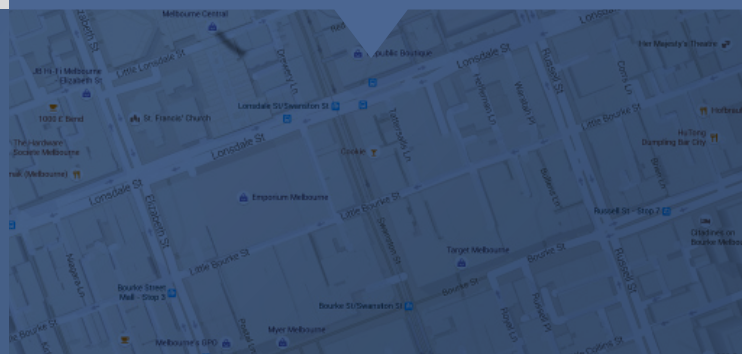

Introduction

Shōnishin is a quick, safe, and effective treatment method that practitioners can incorporate into their practice. The treatment comfortably touches the surface of the skin with an atraumatic instrument providing excellent stimulating properties and is even very comfortable – so there is no pinprick!



Shonishin is used with young children, from babies and toddlers to schoolage children, to treat a range of energetic disharmonies which can lead to physical and emotional symptoms as well as illnesses (e.g. KISS, bed wetting, anxiousness, digestive problems, sleep-disturbances, allergies and asthma). It can also be applied successfully with adults especially to treat anxiety and depression.

The training is based upon the Model of Energetic Development, which Thomas and his wife, Karin Kalbantner-Wernicke, have developed during the last 30 years. The Model of Energetic Development is an attempt to harmonize the knowledge of modern neuroscience, developmental psychology, and developmental physiology with the knowledge and experience of Eastern medicine. It is the basis for understanding the energetic aspect of child development, and, hence the basis for diagnostic and therapeutic processes, depending on the stages of development.
